

CDBG & HOME Notice of Public Hearing Concerning Needs Assessment**Hampton County**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Monday, February 7, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. in County Council Chambers, Hampton County will hold a public hearing to solicit public input on community needs and priorities for housing, public facilities, and economic development in the County. At this public hearing, Hampton County will provide the results of its needs assessment and the activities which might be undertaken to meet identified needs, including the estimated amount proposed to be used for activities that will benefit persons of low and moderate income.

The County will also discuss matters related to housing needs and Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing in anticipation of participation in the Beaufort County/Lowcountry Regional HOME Consortium funded by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

This public hearing and the matters to be discussed are subject to the provisions of the County's Citizen Participation Plan, developed in anticipation of participation in the State of South Carolina's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, providing for the participation of the citizens of the County in the planning and implementation of community and economic development projects which will involve CDBG funds.
