

## **Public Hearing Concerning Application Hampton County**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hampton County, in conjunction with Beaufort, Colleton and Jasper Counties, plans to submit an application to South Carolina Department of Commerce, Grants Administration on or about July 1, 2021, for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) – CV funds. The County is requesting approximately \$858,483 to provide technology to seniors and expand unemployment services in the four-county area. The project has potential to benefit approximately 750 people, of which 51% are Low to Moderate Income.

The hearing will take place at 6 p.m. on Tuesday, June 29, 2021, in Council Chambers, Hampton County Administrative Building, 200 Jackson Avenue East, Hampton, SC 29924.

This public hearing and the matters to be discussed are subject to the provisions of the County's Citizen Participation Plan, developed in anticipation of participation in the State of South Carolina's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The plan provides for the participation of the citizens of Hampton County in the planning and implementation of community and economic development projects which will involve CDBG funds.
