Mr. Brantley Strickland, Project Manager-Hampton County, Southern Carolina Regional Development Alliance, Regarding an Inducement Resolution Pertaining to Love's Travel Stops and Country Stores, Inc. Mr. Strickland stated that Love's Truck Stop will be located on Highway 68. This is a 12 million dollar investment. He explained that they were considering Hardeeville. He stated that they are asking for a 10% SSRC for five years. This will be \$380,000 in new taxes. Council thanked Mr. Strickland for his report.

**MRS. ROSE DOBSON-ELLIOTT, HAMPTON COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, REGARDING RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO STATE RETIREMENT FUND:**

Mrs. Rose Dobson-Elliott, Hampton County Administrator, Regarding Resolution Pertaining to State Retirement Fund. Administrator Dobson-Elliott explained to council that Bamberg County is asking counties to join in their opposition of counties for the increases in the counties contributions of the retirement paid instead of the state's contribution. This is being considered by Act 388. The counties would have to raise millage to do this. Small counties cannot afford this. Administrator Dobson-Elliott stated that council is asked to adopt the resolution presented.
