PRESENTATION

MS. NIKKI TOOMES, UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (USDA)

REPRESENTATIVE, REGARDING THE HAMPTON COUNTY AIRPORT HANGAR PROJECT:

Ms. Nikki Toomes, United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Representative, came before council regarding the Hampton County Airport Hangar Project. Ms. Toomes explained that the total loan would be \$2,666,620 (Two million, six hundred sixty-six thousand, six hundred twenty dollars) at a fixed rate of 3.5% and could be lower. It is for 35 years with 3 years interest only and then the annual payment will be \$139,865 (One hundred thirty-nine thousand, eight hundred sixty-five dollars) annually. If the interest rate is lower before closing then the county could request the lower interest rate. The county would get the construction loan from the bank for the project and then the county would pay the bank off with the USDA loan. The project will close out in 180 (one hundred eighty) days. She explained the contingency. Ms. Toomes explained that any funds not needed, the loan can close for less. Chairman Bishop asked Administrator Dobson Elliott if Mr. Solomons, County Attorney, has reviewed the documents. Administrator Dobson Elliott responded yes. Ms. Toomes explained that she needed council to act on the matter. Council had a short discussion as to whether they could add the item to the agenda. Council would add the matter to the 6:00 p. m. meeting agenda.
