Council met with the Hampton County Economic Development Commission (Commissioners present: DeThane M. Johnson, Chair; C. E. Bullard, Jr. and Dr. Lamar Priester. Staff: Sandy Fowler, Economic Development Executive Director) and the Hampton County Planning Commission (Commissioners present: George Knight, Chair; Wise Batten, Ivy Boles, Lawton O'Cain and Barbara Peeples. Staff - Randy Crews, Hampton County Building Inspector). Council heard from both commissions regarding their recommendation. The Hampton County Planning Commission recommended that the county continue participation with the Yemassee Revitalization Committee and the Hampton County Economic Development Commission recommended that the county not participate with the Yemassee Revitalization Committee's request.
